Ocean Shores Public School P&C is a Volunteer organisation that is **Centerlink** recognised.

If you are required to meet certain obligations with Centerlink in order to maintain your Newstart Allowance, Youth Allowance, Special Benefit or Parenting Payment, you can now volunteer at Ocean Shores Public School to meet your obligations.

We are approved by Centerlink to sign off on the hours you spend doing voluntary work at school, which goes towards your Mutual Obligation Requirements.

Firstly, you need to speak to Centerlink and request they include volunteer work in your Job Plan. Then get in contact with the P&C who can advise you of what positions are currently available.

At present, we are looking for:

Canteen Supervisor: Your primary responsibility would be to help the Co-ordinator operate the canteen on a Friday from 8.30-2.00pm. You would be responsible for running the canteen in the event that the coordinator was unavailable. Approx 6-10hrs per week, depending on your circumstances.

Weekly Canteen Volunteers: We require several helpers to help in the canteen on a Friday. Shifts are from 9.00am-11.30am and 11.30am-1.30pm. Approx 2.5 - 5hrs per week, depending on your circumstances.

Teachers Assistants: Specifically to read with students. This could be 1-15 hrs per week depending on your availability. Numerous positions are available with flexible hours.

Grounds/Garden Assistants: Planting, mulching, watering, weeding, pruning etc . . .

All training will be provided where necessary.
